RESORT RESERVATIONS

Reservation Policies at the Broadmoor:

- All rates are single/double occupancy at \$349.00 (Classic). Maximum of four (4) persons to a room.
Superior Rooms at \$369.00
Premier Rooms at \$399.00
Suites – *call hotel for rates as suites are based on availability.*
Keep in mind that this is the high season for the area and availability is limited.
- **Resort fee: There is a Resort Fee of \$32.00 per day, per room** plus tax. This includes high-speed internet access, unlimited use of Fitness Center, two 12 oz. bottles of water daily in room and one-hour use of paddle boats, on-property resort shuttle service to the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo and The Broadmoor Seven Falls. There is also admission to movies and select matinees in the Little Theatre. Also available are Art and History Tour and Golf Clinic. These items are subject to change.
- **Important Resort Cancellation Policy: In order to prevent a cancellation or change fee of two night's room rate, cancellation or reduction in arrival and or departure dates must be confirmed no later than fourteen days (14) prior to your arrival date.** Individuals with guaranteed reservations who fail to arrive (no show) on the confirmed date will be charged a one night's room rate and tax.
